SUMMER WORKSHOPS

At Chapman University

PLEASE NOTE the times for registration for *dormitory* (resident) students and *commuting* students on the enclosed workshop schedule. Registration will be held in the lobby of Beckman Hall on the Chapman University campus located on the corner of Glassell and University. Free parking is conveniently located in the Orange Street Parking Lot. Workshop participants **must bring** the completed and signed MEDICAL AND PERMISSION FORM (blue) to registration. All fees must be paid in full at that time.

DORM STUDENTS are required to complete registration in Beckman Hall prior to checking into their rooms. Bring a sleeping bag (or twin size sheets and blankets), a pillow, and towel in addition to personal items and clothing. You may also want to bring an alarm clock. You will park your car in the residence parking lot next to the dorms where it will remain for the duration of the workshop. Please take time to read and discuss the enclosed dormitory rules and regulations with your parents.

COMMUTING STUDENTS may park in the Orange Street Parking Lot, next to Beckman Hall, at no charge. Parents may drop off and pick up students in the same lot. Refer to the enclosed class schedule for start and dismissal times.

EVERYONE must wear tennis shoes for the outdoor sessions. Sun block, appropriate head gear, and water bottles are recommended for these sessions. Dress for the entire workshop is casual! Color Guard and Dance Team members will participate in strenuous dance movement on Saturday and should dress appropriately. All students are required to turn off cell phones during class sessions. It is recommended electronic devices NOT be brought to the workshop. Drum Majors and Color Guard members will not need equipment.

PARTICIPATION in all sessions is essential to the success of each individual. Students are expected to attend all sessions, be on time and on task. As prospective leaders, students should help maintain a positive learning environment by contributing to discussions and activities. It is also expected that students be cordial and respectful of their peers and staff members.
